SOUP KITCHEN: 8,742 SETS OF FOOD DISTRIBUTED

In April, the re-establishment of our registration team in Kuala Lumpur was a game-changer, enabling us to register more than 150 individuals at the Medan Tuanku distribution centre and on the streets. This effort has greatly enhanced our ability to track and better meet our clients' needs. We were deeply grateful to A Good Virtues for their generous donation, which helped provide nutritious meals to those in need. Nasi Maqluba, a flavourful dish inspired by Limau Nipis, was distributed to our clients on the streets. We were equally thankful to MServe, as their support allowed us to add an extra day of service to Penang's weekly distribution-a significant boost during the Hari Raya season. However, similar to Penang, Ipoh's street distributions were affected by erratic rainfall, further compounded by a shortage of regular volunteers and food donations. Despite these challenges, our volunteers remain unwavering in their dedication to reaching out and providing essential support. FOOD BANK : 875 DRY FOOD PACKS DISTRIBUTED 34,012.21 KG SURPLUS FOOD RESCUED
