Medical situations such as wound dressings remain to be one of our medic team's main focus. Gangrene situations faced by some of the regular clients warrants ongoing care, which have so far shown little improvement. Clients have been reminded to continue personal wound care efforts to prevent further deterioration. On the other hand, there was a notable increase in requests for inhalers amongst the regular clients. As such, we are appealing for donations of more inhalers for our medical inventory.


EMPOWERMENT: 216 TUBS & 1,337 SETS COOKIES PRODUCED FOR CNY
