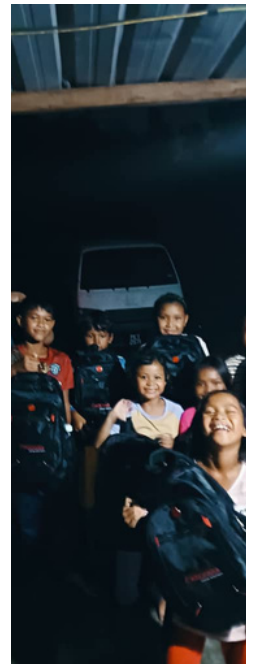


SCHOOL MISSION 2025

Setting new standards! Over the years, our School Mission campaign has grown to support more Orang Asli children.

In 2021, during the pandemic, we supported 565 children. By 2023, this number had grown to 1,100, followed by 1,427 in 2024. This year, we have set a new record, benefiting 2,024 children across 31 villages in six states of Malaysia.

Team C.L.M in Action! Master Chris Leong and his team consistently show kindness by volunteering with KSK for Provision Delivery, bringing essential food packs directly to KSK-registered families.

Lotus's Semuanya OngSem: Together with our long-term partner, Lotus's, we created a record-breaking 1.2km-long snake yee sang, successfully earning a place in the Malaysian Book of Records as the longest yee sang. After spending six hours with 25 volunteers, we also rescued the yee sang and repacked it into 2,000 packets, benefiting approximately 4,000 individuals from two PPRs in Klang Valley.

BFM Podcast: Our very own Justin Cheah was invited to BFM to discuss the topic "Fighting Food Waste with Kechara Soup Kitchen," with 350,000 listeners tuning in daily. He shared insights into KSK's efforts to combat food waste, the inspiring stories behind our work, and the environmental and social ripple effects of our mission.
