

FOOD BANK

Surplus Collection from Pasar Borong has expanded significantly, with collection rounds now happening both in the morning and evening. This change has allowed us to deepen our outreach, ensuring that no good food goes to waste while more families receive the nourishment they need. We've strengthened our partnership with Pasar Borong Selayang, where traders and vendors continue to generously contribute their unsold yet perfectly edible surplus produce. It's a beautiful cycle of care from market to table, guided by kindness.



In just one month, we successfully rescued over 11,000 kilograms of surplus, surpassing the total amount saved in the entire first quarter. This would not have been possible without our committed volunteers, operation teams, and the selfless generosity of our sponsors and donors. From dry provisions to fresh vegetables, every item collected finds a new purpose in the hands of those who need it most. We thank each of you who play a part in this quiet but powerful movement of reducing waste and feeding hope.



EMPOWERMENT

Our April visit to the Orang Asli village was filled with meaningful encounters and memorable experiences. We distributed new and preloved clothes, handed out stationery to the children and for the first time, conducted a medical activity in the village. The trip ended with a beautiful rainbow over the Tok Batin's house, a symbol of the quiet magic that comes from community work.

These visits are more than just outreach. They are a continuous journey of learning, empowerment and trust-building with the community. Education is a fundamental right, and by showing up consistently, we ensure that each child knows they are seen and supported.



MEDIC

Our own KSK Society medic team, in collaboration with St John Ambulance Malaysia from the Kepong and Petaling Jaya chapters, delivered essential general practitioner and optometry services in communities that often go without. Despite the relentless weather, we managed to attend to a total of 233 clients in April, with 106 cases handled solely during the collaboration.

This combined effort brought vital healthcare beyond the city and into underserved areas, reaching those who might otherwise be left behind. Each person was treated with care, dignity and respect, reinforcing our belief that everyone deserves access to basic healthcare, regardless of their circumstances.




EVENTS

We are deeply grateful to everyone who took part and helped extend this vital lifeline.
