FOOD BANK

Provision delivery continued throughout May, ensuring dry goods and essential food items reached families who needed them most. Our surplus food collection efforts remain vital in this chain of kindness, what could have gone to waste now becomes sustenance.

This month alone, we managed to rescue 24,000 kgs of surplus foods from various Partners! We also kicked off Home Assessments at PPR flats, moving door-to-door to understand living conditions and register more households in need. It's slow, deliberate work, built on trust and conversation, but it's how we grow closer to the hearts we aim to help.





EMPOWERMENT

Our baking programme is still running strong, fuelled by passion and orders that help sustain it. Each cookie and loaf carries the story of someone reclaiming their confidence through skill and purpose. Place your orders and be part of their journey.



For requests of more than 50 tubs, we suggest a contribution of RM 15 per tub. For Pineapple Tart, the suggested contribution is RM 20 per tub.





Meanwhile, for Orang Asli Education, as you all know, in 2024, the boat we relied on to reach Atok village was under contract with another company. It was old and unsafe, not suitable for children who needed it to get to school. When Tok Batin asked for help, we listened. With videos, photos, and smiles in hand, we reached out. And someone answered! Thanks to a kind sponsor, 25 children from Atok now have a brand-new, fully equipped long boat to take them safely to SK Merting.






MEDIC

Our medic team worked tirelessly, attending to 236 cases this month. Through a beautiful partnership with Klinik Seri and the Ministry of Health, we continued supporting the houseless via the PeKa B40 programme, taking blood samples, assessing conditions, and creating tailored health plans for those often left behind.

We also received some hopeful news: Ms C, one of our regular patients, showed signs of improvement in her eyesight! The doctor advised her to continue her medication, and we'll be there to help her do just that.
